JONATHAN KOONS AND THE "SPIRIT ROOM"

When you are studying a practice or philosophy there is always some incident, some anecdote that will stand out in your mind as unusual, an item worth remembering. When I began my studies of Spiritualism, it was the story of Jonathan Koons and the Spirit Room that grabbed my attention.

"If you build it, they will come!" Sounds like a line out of the 1989 Kevin Costner movie "Field of Dreams," but this was 1852, and an upscale farmer in a remote area of Ohio was being told to build a "Sound Hall." A visiting medium told

the farmer: "If you build it, they will come." The medium also told the farmer: "You are the most powerful medium on earth" and "all your children are endowed with psychic abilities."

The farmer, Jonathan Koons, living in Millfield Township, Athens County left the séance and went home mulling over what the medium had said. Koons was the father of eight, ranging from a seven months old baby, through to husky teenagers.

Koons decided to build a sound hall. Constructed of logs, a single room, it measured sixteen feet in length and twelve feet wide. He then travelled far and wide acquiring musical instruments and noise-making devices. Neighbors, amused at the idea that spirits would come and play the instruments, donated things to the sound hall. Eventually, they wished they hadn't.

The sound hall soon became famous and many people turned up, sometimes coming from great distances to witness the phenomena. The audience sat on benches facing a so-called "spirit table" where Koons' eldest son, 18 year-old Nahum sat, backed by all the instruments.

The lanterns were turned down – and the action started. Many reported the event as a "fearful din," and the sounds emanating from the log house could be heard a mile away. Sitters holding pieces of phosphorized paper spotted materialized hands carrying instruments around, and spirit faces were seen.

Some visitors, wanting to conceal their identities, wore cloaks and hoods, but the voice behind a floating trumpet announced their names. Relatives, who had crossed over, spoke to sitters and gave proof of survival. Things, including instruments flew around the room including a pistol which seemed to fire itself, sending bullets into the logs, but no one was ever hurt.

In 1852, for instance, a choir of voices was heard at seances of farmers' family Koons. It is the first instance recorded that a trumpet was being used to amplify the voices. He is also credited with constructing the first machine to produce the voices. One may expect it to have worked only in the presence of a physical medium.


